

Suspects linked to

Malefahlo- murder arrested

Colonel Donald Mdhluli, Mpumalanga Provin- with the murder of a 33-year-old victim, Ceci

colonel Donald Mdhluli, Mpumalanga Provincial Police Spokesperson informs the public that 4 suspects appeared before the Mdutjana Magistrate's Court in Siyabuswa facing charges of murder. "They were denied bail and the case was postponed to Thursday 2 September 2021, pending further police investigations," he said. Four male suspects were arrested by the police on Saturday 14 August 2021 in connection

with the murder of a 33-year-old victim, Cecil Malefahlo. The victim was found murdered at Oorlog Village outside Siyabuswa, after he went missing on 17 July 2021. The victim was reported missing by his mother after he left his home with his VW Polo TSI from Malaeneng in Dennilton and never returned. His lifeless body was discovered by a man who was herding cows on Monday 26 July and he was positively

identified by the familv. Colonel Donald Mdhluli, Mpumalanga Provincial Police Spokesperson, said the suspects, Ben Given Baloyi (29), Timothy Tjadi Seloba (35), Simon Ntobeng Njane (39) and Lebogang Rammutla (27) were arrested by members of the Provincial Investigating Unit. "Their arrests emanate to the discovery of the lifeless body of the victim at Oorlog Village outside Siyabuswa. Police were alerted and a murder case was opened. The deceased was later identified as Cecil Malefahla, the man who was reported missing," Mdhluli said. Mdhluli said before the arrests, a preliminary investigation was launched by the Provincial Task Team which led to



them receiving information about the whereabouts of one of the suspects. "They acted on the information and conducted an operation which eventually led to the arrest of the four suspects on Saturday, 14 August 2021 around Dennilton," he said. The Provincial Commissioner of the Police in Mpumalanga, Lieutenant General Semakaleng Manamela, has applauded the team's efforts in ensuring that the suspects are traced and arrested.

#### **Bad state of our hospitals**

Sekhukhune Residence Forum (SRF) has recently lodged a formal complaint with the Health Ombudsman to investigate the poor condition of hospitals in the Sekhukhune District. According to the forum the Limpopo Department of Health denies having poor services in Sekhukhune hospitals. SRF Chairperson, Makeleketse Phasha said all hospitals in Sekhukhune do not comply with quality assurance for healthcare establishment in South Africa. "For instance, all senior positions including the CEO at Matlala Hospital in Tsimanyane are on acting capacity, which is against the quality assurance policy standards," he said. Phasha said the forum has requested the Health Ombudsman to investigate the state of Sekhukhune hospitals to be able to serve the residents. "They should also investigate whether the hospitals meet minimum standards according to the South African Health charter and other international standards," he said. Phasha said the forum will lodge similar complaints with the South African Human Rights Commission.

## Pupils hospitalized after consuming poisonous tree nuts

More than 30 pupils from Makgatsike Primary School in Ga-Marishane outside Jane Furse were rushed to hospital after vomiting and complaining about stomach cramps on Wednesday 18 August. According to the Limpopo Department of Education, the affected learners became sick after eating indigenous poisonous tree nuts, commonly known as Mokolobe. The department stated that one learner arrived with the nuts in the morning and shared with other pupils, which immediately deteriorated their health. "The report we received from the

school indicates that a number of learners started vomiting after arriving in the morning of 18 August 2021.," said Limpopo Department of Health Spokesperson Tidimalo Chuene. She said a total of 39 learners were taken to Marishane Clinic and St Rita's Hospital for immediate medical attention."Twenty-five of them were checked and discharged the same day. Fourteen were admitted and were discharged on 19 August 2021," she said. Chuene confirmed that all affected learners are safely back at school and have no complications after the poisoning incident. "We applaud the swift action by educators at the school and local health workers in attending to the learners immediately after showing signs of poisoning," she said.

During the DCC, Ramathuba outlined the devastation that Covid-19 is wreaking in the communities. "In many families, we are going to have orphans. There are funerals every day," she said. The MEC emphasises the importance of vaccinating to curb the spread of the pandemic in communities. "When we vaccinate you, we protect you from dying and we protect you from getting very sick," said Ramathuba. She indicated that the province and the country will be safer once 70 percent of residents are vaccinated, stating that the vac-

> cines are very safe and go through clinical trials before they can be used. The DCC encouraged all residents of the district to consider getting vaccinated so that their lives can get back to normal. All residents 18 years and older can get their vaccinations.

#### Hlogotlou or Tafelkop Stadium will get a PSL

facelift

The Limpopo MEC for Sport, Arts & Culture ThandiMorakaand the Executive Mayor of Sekhukhune District Municipality Cllr Keamotseng Stanley Ramaila, led a delegation to inspect and assess the Hlogotlou Stadium in Monsterlus and Tafelkop Stadium, as part of government's efforts to assist Sekhukhune United FC to relocate and play its PSL homegames in the district. The team is currently using Makhulong Stadium to play its home games, as a result of lack of sporting facilities that meet the PSL standard in Sekhukhune. Sekhukhune is also home to other PSL outfit, Marumo Gallants FC, formerly known as TTM. The club was recently bought by Sekhukhune based businessman, Ditonkana Sello, and was officially unveiled to the residents of the district earlier this year. A multi-sectoral task team of officials from the provincial government, local government, South African Football Association (SAFA) and Sekhukhune United FC has been put in place to work on this project. According to the district municipality, the task-team has been instructed to put together an assessment report within coming weeks, and a decision will be taken toward ensuring that one of the stadiums is given a facelift that will enable it compliance with the PSL standards.
