Fed-up residents take the law into their own hands

Tafelkop residents, who are fed-up with criminals targeting their community, have taken the law into their own hands. This is after a string of crimes committed at Mashemong Section in the village recently. According to residents, a number of community members, particularly women were robbed of their hand bags when returning from work. Apart from the armed robberies on the streets, there is also a house breaking outcry where residents are woken up by intruders with guns robbing them inside their houses. Some residents have reported wheels removed from their vehicles and other objects including wheelbarrows being stolen during the night. Cases were reported with the police with no arrests made, leading to the community to hunt and catch the thieves to deliver a swift justice. Three alleged criminals were caught in separate incidents and given a taste of mob justice before they could be apprehended to the police. A community member, who did not want to be named, said the criminals have been terrorizing the community since the announcement of the nationwide lockdown in March. "The crimes are committed mainly by nyaope addicts who were chased away from Groblersdal Town as a result of the lockdown regulations. They are back in numbers in the village to commit crime and feed their habit. A number of cases were reported but no one was arrested which angered the community to end up punishing the criminals," he said. He said the criminals target defenseless women who are coming from work to rob them of money and cellphones. "They wait until it gets dark and start with their mission targeting women because they cannot fight back, robbing them on gunpoint," he said. He added that three of the robbers were caught in the act and assaulted brutally by angry residents. He said the latest incident happened a few weeks ago where a middle aged man was caught after robbing a woman who was on her way home from work in Groblersdal. "The woman was on her way home passing next to AFM Church next to Nonyane filling station around 19:00 when a

gun was pointed at her. Her handbag was taken with money inside. She screamed for help, community members responded quickly to give





a chase and the man was caught. Residents mobilized and the alleged criminal was assaulted with anything that they can lay their hand on baying for his blood. He was rescued by the police and still in hospital fighting for his life," he said. He said the other criminals who were assaulted by angry residents were rescued by soldiers who were patrolling to monitor lockdown regulations. Limpopo Provincial Police Spokesperson, Brigadier Motlafela Mojapelo was not immediately available for a comment at the time of going to print.



Regional Football Leagues still in the dark

After the Board of Governors (BOV) that comprises officials of the South African Football Association (SAFA) and the Premier Soccer League (PSL), given a green light for PSL and ABC Motsepe teams to resume with the 2019/2020 League from 8 August, teams participating in the SAFA SAB Regional Leagues are still in the dark. The SAB teams are still awaiting a go-ahead from SAFA as a result of unintended consequences brought by the Covid-19 pandemic. SAFA Sekhukhune SAB Regional Football League Coordinator, Frank Maredi, told the Dispatch that chances of nullifying the leagues are very high in the regions. "This is because our facilities are very poor and not complying with the Covid-19 Regulations. There is no way we can arrange matches to play in sports grounds during this Covid-19 period. Only teams playing in the

upper leagues can qualify as they are using proper facilities like stadiums," he said. According to Maredi, propositions are made that the league will be completed as it stands and the team that occupies the first position per stream declare winners and advance to play in the Sekhukhune Regional Playoffs, where the winners will be representing the region in the provincial level. Maredi added that they are worried about illegal football tournaments and matches taking place around the villages. He added that steps will be taken against coaches and teams owners who will be found violating the law by organizing and participating in those matches. "Four teams were held accountable as we speak and necessary disciplinary actions will be taken against them. Probably, they could be suspended from participating in the regional league," he said.
